Introduction

At Impact Sports Academy ("**Company**" or "**we**"), we respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit or use any of the features of our website www.impactsportsgb.com (our "*Website*") or you access or use the Impact Sports Academy mobile application (the "*App*," collectively with the Website, the "*Online Services*") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect:

- On or through the Online Services.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and the Online Services.
- When you interact with our advertising and applications on third-party websites and services, if those applications or advertising include links to this Privacy Policy.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by Company or any third party; or
- Any third party, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or on the Online Services.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. Children Under the Age of 13

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect various types of information from and about users of our Online Services. We may collect information: (i) by which you may be personally identified, such as name, age, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, or other identifiers by which you may be contacted online or offline; (ii) that is about you but individually does not identify you, such as IP address or other online identifiers; and/or (iii) about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Online Services and usage details (collectively, "**Personal Data**").

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies and other tracking technologies.

Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through our Online Services may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms or responding to prompts on our Online Services. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our Online Services. We may also ask you for information if you report a problem with our Online Services.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our Online Services and of the fulfillment of your orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through our Online Services.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Online Services, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Online Services, including traffic data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Online Services.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

- Web Beacons. Pages of our the Online Services and our e-mails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server integrity).

Third-Party Use of Cookies

Some content or applications, such as embedded videos, on the Online Services are served by third parties. How We Use Your Information

- For any other purpose with your consent.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose Personal Data that we collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy:

- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of the Company's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by the Company about our users is among the assets transferred.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply terms of sale and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others.

Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of the Online Services may then be inaccessible or not function properly.

We do not control third parties' collection or use of your information to serve interestbased advertising. However, these third parties may provide you with ways to choose not to have your information collected or used in this way. You can opt out of receiving targeted ads from members of the Network Advertising Initiative ("**NAI**") on the NAI's website.
